1. **Welcome & Apologies**

2. **Minutes of previous meeting** Proposed: Walter McAllister;

3. **Chair's Report**

Arthur Hannan welcomed everyone saying members are entitled to speak and vote and other attendees were observers.

AH reported the ELLCT was a formally registered and constituted charitable two-tier structure. He informed the meeting all homes in the area have received printed information with an invitation to become members and that there are social media sites and a website all with up to date information.

AH reported that Trustees & members had spoken in favour of the affordable housing development at the recent TLLNP planning meeting held in Drymen with planning permission being approved. AH informed the meeting the ELLCT had secured a Scottish Land Fund grant to purchase the land for the four workers homes.

There was a successful Community Fun Day held in September with well over 100 people enjoying the event.

AH told the meeting the ELLCT had been asked for input at a recent meeting about the Drymen to Balmaha cycle path completion and the ELLCT was in the process of completing the land transfer of the old toilet block site in Balmaha.

AH invited the members to bring any projects to the group's attention and this can be done by contacting a trustee or via the website or social media. Sheena McAllister suggested Gwen's Bench was in need of maintenance. AH said this could be added to the agenda to be discussed at the next Trustees' meeting.

#### 4. **Treasurer's Report**

Louise Robertson reported that in November 2017 the ELLCT had receipts of £4813 and at the end of October 2018 the accounts showed a balance of £2552.
