2. **Minutes of previous meeting** (Tuesday, 20/9/21) Prop: WMcA, Sec: DF
3. **Community Hydro Scheme**
DF updated progress on the scheme. DF had been asked to consult the trustees regarding incorporating a group from outwith the ELLCT area of benefit into the ELLCT. As there was only three trustees present (the minimum required to hold a meeting) it was decided to postpone a decision until all trustees could be consulted.
4. **Meetings**
 - Matt Buckland (MB), LLTNP Visitor Manager, MM updated MB on the various projects the ELLCT is involved with.
 - Elaine Nicol (EN) & Willie Collins (WC), Stirling Council, updated MM and DF about the works starting at the end of November 2021 along the C6. The works will start at Rowardennan and work the way down the C6 toward Balmaha and there is to be a public meeting to answer any residents queries.
